A Short History

WHO WAS NOAH WEBSTER?

Known as the father of the American Dictionary, Noah Webster was an American lexicographer, textbook pioneer, English-language spelling reformer, political writer, editor, and author.

He was born in this house in 1758, and would go on to write the *Blue Backed Speller*, which taught countless early American children to read. He became a teacher, a lawyer, and an author, and in 1828, he published the first dictionary of American English.



Our Space

THE HAMILTON GALLERY

The museum's main function room accommodates 50 persons (seated) and 75 persons for standing cocktail events. The space is equipped with chairs, tables, and AV projection capabilities. Two doors open up directly to the terrace.

THE EAST GALLERY

This changing exhibit space is perfect for small gatherings, a place to mingle before an event, or additional space to host more guests.

THE WEST TERRACE

Our beautiful and private blue stone terrace, secluded amongst the pines, is adjacent to the Hamilton Gallery and available for your fair weather entertaining. Terrace includes festive lighting and outdoor furniture that can accommodate 24 guests seated or 40 standing.

18TH-CENTURY REPRODUCTION KITCHEN

Adjacent to the Hamilton Gallery, this early American-inspired space features an open-hearth fireplace and works to complement your event as a second event area.

WHY WEST HARTFORD?

Centrally located within the state, West Hartford provides a beautiful backdrop to any event. Incorporated in 1854, the town serves as a hub of culture and history.
